Come run, jump and throw at 900m above sea level

Katoomba District Athletics Club is a long-established athletics Club in the upper Blue Mountains. Established in 1973 and running out of Katoomba as a Little Athletics Club, it now operates from Pitt Park in Wentworth Falls and is affiliated with both Little Athletics NSW and Athletics NSW.



Participants are drawn mainly from Lawson to Blackheath, but members are welcome from across the Blue Mountains. We cater for athletes aged 4 – 17 years in Little Athletics competition and athletes aged 12 years upwards in Athletics NSW sanction competition.

Our competition program runs from October to March

each year on Saturday mornings between 8:30am and 12 noon subject to weather and Council restrictions. We offer most Little Athletics NSW events and a restricted set of Athletics NSW events (we do not offer pole vault or hammer throw).

Our ground at Pitt Park Wentworth Falls has a 7 lane 400m athletics track, two dual run-up long jump pits, two discus cages and two shotput circles. We also include High Jump and Javelin in our programs. The centre provides coaching in select events by accredited coaches on set afternoons during the competition season depending on demand.

A number of our athletes compete at both Little Athletics and Athletics NSW sanctioned meets. We have regular and solid representation at Little Athletics Region and State Championships, as well as NSW Athletics Country Championships and other meets.

In the coming years we will see major development activity at Pitt Park thanks to Blue Mountains City Council and the NSW Government, where the track will be upgraded to World Athletics specifications, drainage improved and a new Club house and storage constructed.

so easy. And finally to Costa, Steve, Lucy, Izzy and De who don't have kids competing at Little Athletics, but are still so dedicated to our club – thank you!



Registrar's Report - 2023/2024 Season

The season saw a full calendar of events and 141 Little Athletics NSW registrations, to run, jump and throw each week, a slight increase on the previous season despite an increased financial burden from interest rates lifts and inflation.

Excitingly there was an even split between genders, 70 male and 71 female, with more females joining our fantastic sport. The largest age group award is shared between the Under 10 and Under 12 age groups with 16 registrations each. A credit to those age managers and their helpers who support their little athletes throughout the season, improving their self efficacy, to return to the sport the following season.



Our ANSW memberships grew in the 2023/2024 season to 25 members, consisting of 2 open memberships, 11 junior memberships, 2 youth memberships, 3 community athletics memberships, 7 volunteer memberships, with most representing our club at various events through the season. Next season will see an intergrated membership offering which will allow all club athletes to compete at more events without added membership costs.

Congratulations to all our club athletes on everything you have achieved this season!! No matter what level you achieved, it is competing against yourself each week and the personal bests that should be praised.

Thank you to all the parents, grand parents, guardians, siblings, age managers and committee members who make our Saturdays (and the other days & nights) possible.

Lastly, I look forward to seeing and hearing about our little athletes achieving great things in their school carnivals and can not wait to see what the 2024/25 season holds for our fantastic club.

Treasurer's Report - 2023/2024 Season

I would like to present a brief outline of our Auditor's Report for the season 2023-2024

The total income for 2023-2024 was \$14,329.69. This was down on last season by \$5502.03. Whilst the income is less than the previous couple of years, as the Treasurer I am not concerned with the downturn of income as the previous year's income includes monies received for zone and region shirts (listed as zone registrations) an incentive not implemented at this year's zone- which the club did not receive any profit or income from.

The major income for this season includes:

- Registration (listed as Sports STG, Perpetual and Athletics) \$8,816.51
- Uniform sales \$3,664.37

The total expenditure for 2023-2024 was \$16,650.23. This was down from last season however it was more than our yearly income.

The major annual expenditure for the season includes:

- Uniform purchases \$4,621.90
- Oval Hire \$2,578.00
- Admin and registration fees \$923.16

The club also invested in a one-off expense of \$892.51 for new Branded gazebo covers. These new gazebo covers assist with club identification at competitions and has been well received by the athletes and families. This expense forms part of the club's focus on strategically investing in updating our resources (Updating of the starting equipment last year) to continually improve the professionalism of the club and put us in a strong position to host Championship events in the future, which will significantly boost our income.

Over the next few years, one off purchases like this will be more frequent as we move forward with the significant ground upgrades which will be completed over the next few years.

During the off-season, the Committee will look at the next lot of expenses and determine what fundraising or sponsorships will be needed to maintain a healthy bank balance whilst creating a high functioning professional club post the ground works and club house re-build.

The club is still in a strong financial position for the season 2023-2024 with a bank balance as of the 31st March 2023 at \$31,793.05

Finally, I would like to thank The committee, Marcus from Cafe to U, The age Managers and all our parent helpers. Without your commitment and dedication, the club would not be a success.

I hope to see you all next season for even a better Athletics season.
